The Monterey County Rape Crisis Center offers a 47+ hour state certified training to become a Sexual Assault Counselor. During the training you will learn about crisis intervention and advocacy, community resources, the reporting process, collaboration with other agencies on behalf of survivors, and best practices when working with survivors of sexual assault, human trafficking, and child abuse; and their significant others. The training is offered twice a year in the Spring and Fall.

What do volunteers do?

- Respond to the hospital or police departments to assist survivors during sexual assault forensic exams and the reporting process
- Assist at MCRCC's community events and fundraisers

MCRCC was founded in 1973 and is sustained by a supportive community passionate about ending sexual assault, human trafficking and child abuse. Any amount you give goes directly towards this mission. Help sustain MCRCC by setting up a recurring monthly donation.

- \$15 enables a crisis line call from someone in need to talk to MCRCC staff and advocates
- \$50 teaches a classroom of elementary school students the skills they need to stay safe
- \$100 supports MCRCC to train law enforcement on working with sexual assault survivors
